### MINUTES OF THE 2014 ANNUAL MEETING OF THE AMERICAN MANCHESTER TERRIER CLUB LEXINGTON, KY AUGUST 31, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 8: 45 PM by President, Lisa Nonog.

#### **President's Report**

Lisa thanked everyone for their attendance and support of the Board over the last year.

#### **Secretary's Report**

There has been an excellent response to the Judges ballots which will be counted on 9/15. Motion was made to publish a complete tally by John Gorman. Seconded by Janna Morgan. Passed. Complete tally will be published on the Members List.

The judge for the 2015 National in Lincoln, NE is Carolyn Herbal. The date is October 2, 2015 and it will be held in the Lancaster Event Center. Marla Zoz, Chairman, passed out an information sheet on the show. The 2016 National will be held in Northern California in September with the Sir Francis Drake Kennel Club. It is an excellent facility and more details will be available soon.

Kelly Craig asked to be heard at this point with a question about the awards for 2013's top performance dogs who were not mentioned with the other awards given out at the Banquet. It was an oversight and will be quickly corrected. The dogs will be published in the Newsletter with the other awards.

#### **Treasurer's Report**

Jeanette had a consolidated report available for the members and for publication in the next Newsletter. The club is in very good shape financially with an ending balance of \$33,436.11. Dedicated funds include Rescue, Health and District balances and come to \$20, 241.61 as of July, 2014. She also reported that the auction at this year's banquet brought in \$2400.00. She will pay Richard Roach for gas. She also thanked Barbie Munafo and Brian Muncy for their work in the Hospitality Room.

#### **Committee Reports**

##### **Newsletter**

Cheryl Roach thanked everyone for their support of the Newsletter and requested continuing submissions and photos. Deadlines are the 28<sup>th</sup> day of the month prior to publication. At this time we are about 50/50 on electronic and hard copy numbers. Hard copies are about \$210 an issue and \$4.00 postage. Cheryl reminded everyone that the online copies are in full color.

### **Rescue and Health**

Michelle Barlak made the report for herself and Tammy Myers (co-chair). There are still three dogs in Rescue under the old guidelines. Using the new program, about 12 dogs have been helped to find new homes this year. Under the new procedures, any AMTC member can apply for emergency financial help in an emergency concerning a rescue. This is not for maintenance funds. There will be a complete report available in the next Newsletter.

Michelle also reported on Health which she Chairs. She thanked Dr. Regina Allen who is a vet and an AMTC member for her ongoing updates on various medical problems.

Any and all information concerning dogs in regards to Juvenile Cardio Myopathy will be confidential if the owners wish. At this point we need to decide if it is worthwhile to buy a Holter Monitor. We have the vests that the monitor is attached to and they could be copied.

We are at an emotionally draining stage in this ongoing investigation as we really need to have more specimens. This would involve breeding pups from known cardio carriers unless we can get more owners to participate individually.

### **New Business**

Sue Thrasher moved and Cheryl Roach seconded that a committee be formed to investigate ways to drop the costs of printing/mailing the hard copies of the Newsletter by increasing dues of the members who request them. Sue and Cheryl were appointed Chairs and will report to the Board.

Motion to adjourn was made by Betty Hodges and seconded by Bev Liedner. Carried.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:25

I have been involved with dogs since I was four years old. I started training my pets after seeing dogs in commercials and at the circus performing tricks and watching "Lassie" on television. I took my first official obedience training classes as a teenager, but didn't actually compete with a dog until after I completed college.

I have owned Dachshunds (smooth and long haired), a Shetland Sheepdog, a Springer Spaniel, and Collies (rough and smooth). I purchased a Toy Manchester Terrier from Mary Gonzales in September 2013. I currently own two smooth collies and one TMT.

I have trained dogs in obedience, rally, agility, herding, conformation, and barn hunt. I have held offices in the local dog training club and have volunteered at numerous local dog events including trials, shows, fund raisers, CGC testing, etc. I have also had several Therapy dogs and currently volunteer with my local therapy dog group. I have also volunteered as a judge at a local obedience match.


I was not born into a dog show family and never participated in any Juniors events and so everything I have learned has come from my desire to read, listen and learn from my mentors and from sage dog trainers that I've met over the years.

I have had quite a bit of success in showing my dogs, who are always owner handled. My smooth collie and Toy Manchester are both currently ranked as the #1 in their breeds for Owner Handler competition in 2014. I have finished dogs with AKC, UKC, & International conformation Championships as well as AKC Grand Championship and a UKC Altered Best in Multi Breed Show and UKC Altered Reserve Best in Multi Breed Show. I have won Group 1 in AKC & UKC on several occasions and have many other group placements as well. I have earned UCDX, Rally Excellent, Agility Excellent, UKC Grand Agility Champion 5 level, Herding Started titles on Sheep and Ducks, and Barn Hunt Novice & Open titles. I have won a High in Trial in both obedience and agility competition. One of my dogs was awarded the Shining Star award by the CCA and was also inducted into the Oklahoma Veterinary Medical Association - Hall of Fame.

I have been a member of the Collie Club of America for almost 20 years and have served on their Working Collie Committee for several of those years. I was heavily involved in the WCC planning of the 2011 CCA National which was for their 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. I have also helped with many of the CCA Central Regional Herding Trials.

While I am considering breeding my first litter in the coming year, my dogs are my pets first and foremost and breeding is not my main goal. I believe in having well rounded dogs that have the character and stability to go anywhere with me and be a great representative of their breed. I have put in the last twenty years learning and studying conformation and pedigrees and hope to put that effort into a breeding that will produce an even better dog.

I am interested in joining the American Manchester Terrier Club so that I can learn more about this breed and help in promoting these fine little dogs.

## **HEALTH CHAIR REPORT**

### **Canine Brucellosis**

Regina R. Allen DVM

Canine Brucellosis, caused by the organism *Brucella canis*, is the only bacterial organism proven to cause infertility in female dogs, and is of special concern in kennels. It causes abortions and stillbirths in bitches, and inflammation of the testicles and related structures, along with sperm abnormalities in dogs. Although spayed or neutered animals do not show reproductive signs, they may demonstrate infection of the intervertebral disks (discospondylitis), eyes (anterior uveitis), kidneys (glomerulonephritis), and meninges (meningoencephalitis). Only domestic and wild canines are susceptible to *B. canis*; other domestic animals appear resistant when experimentally infected.

There are several routes of natural transmission, most commonly ingestion or inhalation of the organism in aborted materials. Sources of exposure also include vaginal discharges, urine, milk, and semen. Venereal and transplacental infection also occur. The highest concentration of *B. canis* organisms is in vaginal discharge, and continues up to six weeks after abortion. Urinary shedding begins a few weeks after the onset of infection, and lasts for at least three months. Transmission via fomites (non-living objects) can also occur, but *B. canis* is susceptible to common disinfectants even though it can live a long time outside the host in soil, dust, and organic material.

Signs of disease are usually not obvious, as it does not interfere with normal estrous cycling in intact bitches. There is no age or breed disposition. Conception failure, resorption of embryos, and late-term abortions are most common, without signs of illness in the dam. If the pregnancy reaches full-term, then both live and dead puppies may be born. Most live puppies die within hours to days, and if they survive, they will demonstrate some or all of the following: fever, swollen lymph nodes, seizures, enlarged spleen, bone infections, skin infections, eye inflammation, and bleeding.

Canine Brucellosis should be considered in all dogs with reproductive problems. The Rapid Slide Agglutination Test (RSAT) is a commercial test that can be used for pre-breeding screening. Infected animals may be more difficult to

diagnose, and it is best to use more than one diagnostic tool if the illness is suspected. A definitive diagnosis can be made via culture of samples from the genital tract or milk, urine, and aborted fetuses. Additional tissues that can be cultured include lymph nodes, spleen, prostate, testis, liver, uterus, bone marrow, and clinically affected vertebrae or eyes. Antibiotic therapy will interfere with culture results.

The disease is zoonotic, which means that it can be transmitted to humans, and may be difficult to diagnose due to low suspicion of infection. Some infected people remain asymptomatic, while others develop non-specific flu-like symptoms such as fever, chills, headache, malaise, back pain, night sweats, and enlarged lymph nodes, liver, and spleen. Some recover spontaneously, while others have flu-like symptoms that wax and wane. Other complications include arthritis, chronic fatigue, testicular inflammation, neurologic signs, anemia, abscesses, kidney infection, and heart inflammation, which cause a wide variety of symptoms. However, the fatality rate is low, approximately 2% - 5% in untreated individuals. Treatment in humans is usually with a prolonged course of two antibiotics; however, relapses may be seen.

Prevention of the organism from entering populations of breeding dogs is of utmost importance. Since the organism can be spread by mating with fresh, chilled, or frozen semen, or by contact with aborted fetus tissues, normal vaginal discharge, and urine, pre-breeding screenings play an important role in prevention of disease transmission. Uninfected animals living with infected animals were found to acquire the disease within six months.

No treatment is certain to eliminate *B. canis* from infected dogs. A combination of two antibiotics used long-term, plus neutering, may appear to cure the dog, but the disease can recur during periods of stress. Intact animals **must not** be used for breeding, even if treated with antibiotics! Euthanasia must also be considered, especially when infected animals live in a household with an immunocompromised individual.

Canine Brucellosis is often overlooked during dog breeding. While pre-breeding screening is important, we must remember that dogs often come in contact with urine and vaginal secretions at shows, which could potentially spread the disease. Because of its zoonotic potential, *B. canis* infection must always be suspected in bitches that have reproductive problems, especially late-term abortions. Wear gloves when handling aborted fetuses and associated tissues, and disinfect the area with a common kennel disinfectant after cleaning up all organic debris. The fetuses may also be saved for culture and diagnosis. If the diagnosis is confirmed, then neutering and long-term treatment with antibiotics or euthanasia are the two options to help prevent further spread of the Canine Brucellosis.

### **Year End Health Chair Report**

As I have outlined the recommendation to perform holter monitoring on parents and siblings of puppies who have died from Juvenile Cardiomyopathy (JCM) I will just jump right in. This summer we had the opportunity to rent a holter monitor and test the parents and littermate of a puppy who was confirmed, via necropsy and pathology report, to have died from JCM. The good news for the 3 dogs and their owner is that all three dogs had perfectly normal hearts. The bad news for our study is that the holter monitoring yielded no results that were helpful to the study. We currently have no way of diagnosing living carriers or affected dogs. As a result the importance of developing a genetic test to identify at gene at the DNA level becomes even more important. No breeder can claim their lines are free of JCM because we have no way to test for it.

Fortunately, we only spent \$173.64 from the Health committee fund to do the holter monitoring. We received a \$1,000 donation towards the JCM study and the Canadian Manchester Terrier Club paid for the holter monitoring vest. Totally unrelated to JCM and the heart study: The AMTC and CMTC now jointly own a holter monitoring vest and I am happy to loan it out to breeders who need one to holter monitor their dogs (borrower must pay shipping). Several doberman clubs will rent out their holter monitors to breeders for about \$50. Anyone looking for more information can feel free to contact me. Please note, I have a new email. ## **AKC DELEGATE'S REPORT**

Delegate's report – September 2014

After the last delegate's meeting, I had time to reread my report for June. In essence, the report for June's Parent Committee meeting and this meeting were the same. So, if you don't want to spend time reading this report, reread that report.

It's September, so it must be time for the AKC Delegate's assembly. Good person that I am, I trotted off on Sunday to the committee meetings, to hear all the good things (or not so good things) the AKC had to say. Unfortunately, I was unable to attend Monday's meeting, but I can tell you what happened even though I wasn't there.

There wasn't much new stuff covered at the Parent's Committee meeting, but here, in essence is what did occur.

Discussion was held concerning e-balloting yet again. It seems that although clubs can discuss business by e-mail, if the state in which the club is incorporated does not allow e-balloting, the club cannot entertain the notion of doing it. Since I don't know what the laws of the state of Washington allow, we need to check that out before we even think about doing balloting on line. There is a great deal of confusion about this, and it might just not be worth the effort to find out. This does not preclude teleconferencing however, which is allowed.

Meet the Breeds in New York: will be held this year at the pier along with the agility trial. The rental of the Javits Center became prohibitive, so it was decided to move the festivities to the pier in February. Meet the Breeds at Eukanuba remains the same.

Parent Club Rescue Alliance group: The AKC is asking for information about every clubs rescue group and is trying to establish an on-line group for all breeds.

AKC breed classifieds was originally only for people with puppies for sale. However, they have decided to allow breeders to put their names up on the web site even if they don't have puppies on the ground. When this will happen I do not know. However, out of curiosity I did go to the AKC web site. There are presently three breeders listed, two are AMTC members, the third is a lady I have never heard of. She is not an AMTC member, she does not, she says, health test her puppies, neither will she take them back. But, they are all AKC registered. I don't know how the AKC will rectify this problem, but obviously something needs to be done.

Speaking of such things, the criteria for Breeder of Merit should include requirement that all health tests recommended by the club should be done before the BOM is approved.

The National Owner/Handler mandate has been changed. Parent clubs and Specialty clubs no longer need to have owner/handler groups, but all breed clubs holding two events must have it at least at one show.

Since my kennel club has been having problems finding judges for our impending CAT, I felt obligated to attend the Performance committee meeting in the afternoon. Put simply, there are not enough judges for these events. I put my two cents in, they are aware of the problem, and hopefully will rectify it soon.

On Monday the delegate's met. I was unable to attend, but the major activity of this session was the election of members to the standing committees. That was just about it. Since these are strictly Delegate's committees, I don't think you all really care who these people are. If you do, ask me, and I will gladly provide that information to you. It is difficult to think the end of 2014 is already upon us. Where has the time gone? It seems like yesterday we were in Kentucky at the National. I would like to congratulate all the winners at the National shows and thank all those involved who made it successful.

We are working hard in District 8 to offer two Specialties in 2015:

- ❖ Rose City Classic (January 14-18, 2015) Portland, Oregon. Lisa Nonog will show chair. We are hopeful to have AKC approval from the AKC any day now. Donna Renton will judge sweeps prior to the designated specialty on Saturday, January 17<sup>th</sup>.
- ❖ Woofstock Cluster (June 3-7, 2015) in Vallejo, California. Jeanette Tonini will show chair. We are in the planning phase and should have more information for the next newsletter.

District 8 is offering an All-Breed AMTC agility trial held at Argus Ranch Facility for Dogs on December 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> in Auburn, Washington.

Since my last report, we held our first AMTC All-breed agility trial in Northern California. The trial was at the Cabernet Indoor Soccer Facility in Livermore. With the lack of rain and relentless heat, California is in a severe drought and grass areas are nothing but a dream. Local agility clubs are scrambling to find indoor venues during the summer. Luckily, Cabernet is now offering their facility for dog sports. However, there is a learning curve as most local dogs train outdoors or undercover on dirt. I say approximately because we did not get a hard count on the ribbons collected. Next year Cabernet is lowering their costs by \$200. I remain optimistic we will increase entries as local competitors become more familiar with indoor agility. As of now, all weekends are booked at this facility for agility during the summer, so the demand is certainly there.

Furthermore, if you have not heard already, District 8 was approved by the AMTC to host the 2016 National Specialty. It is slated for September 2016 in Vallejo, California, during the Sir Francis Drake Kennel Club weekend which is a four-day cluster. The co-show chairs are Jeanette Tonini and Dianna Texter. They are in the early planning phase and have a huge job ahead, but I have no doubt it will be an absolute success with tons of doggie fun for everyone. We hope to offer rally, obedience, agility, lure coursing and barn hunt. I will keep you informed as I learn more. Happy Holidays and have a healthy and prosperous New Year everyone!

## Callie Caoua Best in Show Daily Juniors Edition, July 26, 2014

My name is Callie Caoua; I'm 15 years old and have been showing dogs for 4 years. Unlike most junior handlers, I did not grow up into the sport of dogs. My parents bought a Bloodhound when I was 10 years old. That summer we went camping and met a man that suggested I join 4H with my dog. In the fall I took his advice and joined my local 4H dog club in Jefferson County, Colorado. I started to train my Bloodhound Bourbon through the 4H club and discovered how much I enjoyed working with and training dogs.



My Mom worked with a schoolteacher named **Carol Henning** that showed dogs in AKC. She was the one who introduced me to the AKC world of dog shows. She mentioned I should try AKC dog shows, I entering in juniors for more practice in preparation for the County and State Fair. As the fair approached I was feeling very prepared, because I had been doing so well in the AKC Juniors Competition. All of my so-called "practice" at AKC shows paid off at the County Fair as I qualified to go to the Colorado State Fair. That year at the State Fair I placed eighth with Bourbon, I was ecstatic. After that I was hooked and decided that along with going to college my goal is to make a career out of training, handling, and showing dogs.



After the Fair was over I continued to show in AKC and train with my 4H club. Not knowing at the time I was going to get into showing my parents had already neutered Bourbon which limited me to showing in AKC junior's and 4H only but I wanted to show in the breed ring too. The hard part was that in Colorado there are not many AKC dog shows, and since I am still in school traveling was often not an option. I started to look for a breed that majors would be easier to find without having to travel much. A 4H leader from another county had an English Mastiff, and I knew I loved big dogs so I started to research the breed. In 2011 I bought a Mastiff with my money that I had saved over the years and named him Laughlin, "BOE DOG'S LAUGHLIN WINS BIG IN NEVADA CGC." We got Laughlin when he was 4 months old I started training him at a local conformation class with help from **Troy Cashman** the owner of Mantayo Kennels; Laughlin was my new show dog. I also thank **Mary Delisa** from Divine Mastiffs for teaching and mentoring me about this breed. I soon learned that big slobbering dogs like a Bloodhound or Mastiff are not what a judge likes to see in the juniors ring.



In 2012 through Carol I met **Dawn-Renee Mack** she had said to Carol, "I wish a junior would fall out of the sky to show my Dachshund Ryan, GCH DELANY V RUGER THX 2 DOXIKOTA." Ryan at the time was a champion and I was that junior who fell out of the sky to show Ryan in the breed and junior rings. Dawn would bring Ryan to meet me at Mantayo Kennel's once a week for training. Ryan would stay the weekend with me during a show but other than that she lived with Dawn. Dawn became a huge mentor for me as she has taught me so much about different dog breeds and being part of the dog show world.

Within a year I put a Grand Championship title on Ryan and had the opportunity that spring to go to the 2013 Dachshund Club of American Nationals at Purina Farms in Missouri. I won my juniors class and was named the #10 Dachshund Junior Handler of 2012. This was a huge honor for me especially since this was the first national I had ever attended. Also Ryan was the first dog I have ever put a title on which made my mentors and me very proud.



The summer of 2013 my family moved to Hilliard, Ohio from Denver, Colorado. This meant I would have to find a new dog for juniors because Ryan needed to stay with Dawn. But this time rather than getting a retired show dog from someone else, I wanted to experience the challenges of training my own Juniors dog from the bottom up. I wanted to have a dog to call my own, a dog to be proud of knowing that I trained all myself. I knew I wanted to get a Toy Manchester Terrier as my new juniors dog. I was very familiar with the breed since we have a retired Manchester named Bounce at home that my sister Carlie trained as her 4H dog. With help from **Jerri Hobbs** another mentor; I was able to purchase a Toy Manchester. In the fall, soon after I moved to Ohio, I picked up Dalilah "BURMACK'S FIELDS OF DALILAH FLOWERS," when

she was 8 weeks old. I started conformation classes at Safari Handling and Training in Columbus. I thank **Joe T. Caton** and **Kathy Elier** for their mentorship and encouragement while training a small dog.

This past April at the Fort St. Clair Kennel Club Dog Show in Eaton, Ohio I won Best Junior Handler for the first time ever with my Manchester Dalilah. After 4 years of showing and training I finally reached this point. I was filled with a feeling of accomplishment, knowing that I had trained Dalilah from the bottom up with the help from so many mentors. This has taught me a life lesson that sometimes the best things come to those who are patient and work hard for them. Thank you Carol and Jerri for introducing me to this amazing breed and always being there when I need advice.



I started as a freshman at Hilliard Davidson High School and joined the Wildcat Marching Band. I also joined the K-9 Wonderdogs 4H club in Franklin County with my Mastiff Laughlin, this has kept me busy preparing for County and State Fair this July. As part of my 4h project with Laughlin I also do therapy work called PetPals. With my 4h club we go into assisted living and nursing home facilities to visit the patients. Laughlin is great for therapy work because of his size. It is very easy for the patients who might be in wheelchairs or in beds to visit with him. I really enjoy doing therapy work with Laughlin and hope to get his CGCA and TDI titles so that I can further my therapy work. With so many AKC dog shows in Ohio it is often hard to attend them because of the other activity's I'm a part of.

Thank you to my family for always supporting me, my Father for paying the entry fees, and my Mother for taking me to the shows. With their support and my can-do attitude I am going to continue showing dogs and love every minute whether I win or lose.
