2ND VICE-PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Each year, the Board shall select one person chosen for their good work which benefited the AMTC and its members in the preceding Club year.

The Awards Committee shall accept nominations from the membership between January 1 and April 15 of each year on a form provided in the Club's November Newsletter or from the Club Website. The Committee shall compile and submit nominations to the Board provided:

- the nominee is Club a member in good standing with their membership encompassing the year of nomination; and,
- the nomination form is accompanied by a summary of qualification for the nominee for the preceding year.

The award shall be engraved and presented to the recipient at the Annual Awards Banquet.

The American Kennel Club issues the Outstanding Sportsmanship Award to clubs to award to the individual in the club who deserves special recognition for having contributed to the club and to the breed. This award was formerly known as our Good Sportsmanship Award. It is now time for us to choose the member who best exemplifies good sportsmanship to the world.

When making your nomination, please consider the following criteria:

1. The nominee must be and have been a member in good standing for at least seven years
2. The nominee has to have been an active exhibitor either in breed and/or performance/companion events in the past, if circumstances do not allow for doing so in the present for an extended period of time.
3. The nominee must be an active, contributing member of the AMTC, and have been willing to help whenever needed at any AMTC District event.
4. The nominee has to have demonstrated those aspects of good sportsmanship which we all admire and aspire to emulate.
5. The nominee represents to the public the best aspects of our breed and our sport. Is willing to give time to new people coming into our breed and the general public and to educate them about our dogs whenever possible.

Please either mail or e-mail them to me by April 1 with brief biographies of the nominee and your reasons for believing he/she is deserving of this honor. A committee appointed by the Board will review all nominations and determine who the winner for the year will be. The award will be presented at our National at the annual banquet.

Reports of Officers:

President – nothing new to report

1st V.P - Christina suggested a sign in sheet for the AGM be placed at the ‘board table’ instead of elsewhere in the room in order to ensure proper member identification and accurate attendance count. Guests/non-members will have

Christina also noted the AKC has contacted her concerning their questioning our timeframe for holding our annual meetings. Christina has drafted a letter of explanation to this effect and is waiting for a response.

Also noted was having received a large number of requests from people looking for Manchesters. Regarding the proposed Facebook page for official AMTC business...Kathy received information from BMTC member, Estella Phil, regarding the guidelines utilized by their club. These will be reviewed and edited to meet our needs and presented at the AGM during discussion and possible approval of the newly revised Standing Rules and Guidelines.

September 4th, 2019 AMTC Board Meeting (Postponed from August 28th, 2019)

The September 4th, 2019 AMTC teleconference board meeting was called to order by President, Susan Thrasher, at 7:37 p.m. CDT.

Roll Call: Officers Present: President: Susan Thrasher, 1st V.P.: Christina Caridis, 2nd V.P.: Roberta Berman, Treasurer: Dianna Texter, Secretary: Kathy Nissen – Board members present: Jean Good, Patrick Mackesey, Ellen Murtagh. Beverly Leidner – Absent.

Reports of Officers:

President's Report – nothing new to report.

1st V.P. , Christina Caridis – Due to the AKC approving our By Laws revision and now going from eight (8) districts to five(5), Christina noted she has contacted those current District Governors asking if anyone would like to remain as that district's governor if still residing in the newly organized districts. She also noted we had four governors that would like to step down.

Christina also noted the redistricting will require redistribution of district funds in a fair and equitable manner. A proposal has been submitted by board member, Ellen Murtagh, that the board believes to be fair, however, this will be an item for discussion during the 2019 AGM. The proposal reads as follows:

- 1) Divide district funds by the number of voting members in the district.
- 2) Assign each person the value per district.
- 3) Add up the amount for each person in the new district and that becomes the new district's funds.

Or

Total the amount in district funds and divide by 5 (new number of districts).
These two options will be discussed at the AGM.

2nd V.P. Report – Roberta noted she and Jean Good have been working diligently on the revision/updating the schedule of points for Manchesters to be in the HOF. This proposed revision will be reviewed more in depth at the September 25th board meeting.

Secretary's Report: Kathy noted we currently have two member applicants pending approval. She has also contacted all Committee Chairpersons and District Governors asking for submission of their annual reports for presentation at the 2019 AGM.

Treasurer's Report: Dianna noted the current balance in the AMTC account. She also presented a request from Agility Chairperson, Karen Langlois, regarding the need for funds for an upcoming trial. Motion to approve Karen Langlois' request made by Dianna Texter, 2nd by Christina Caridis. All approved. Motion carried.

Motion by Christina Caridis to request approval for what Is now District 5, to hold a specialty during Woofstock in 2020. Motion to approve made by Patrick Mackesey, 2nd by Ellen Murtagh. All approved. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business:

Christina noted everything is on track for our 2019 AMTC National Specialty. Also noted, she and Dianna paid for an ad in Show Sight Magazine promoting our National event.

Christina also noted trophies have been sponsored for Montgomery. It was decided no year would be inscribed on the trophy should any not be awarded and utilized at this event in the future.

AKC Breed Flyer – Jo Ann Emrick has suggested the club needs to update the photos in the flyer the AKC sends to new owners registering Manchester terriers. The board has agreed we will put a notice in the November newsletter for photo submissions to be sent to the Secretary, Kathy Nissen, who will then send them on to Jo Ann for submission to the AKC.

AMTC Facebook page – Christina noted she has drafted the proposed language for utilizing a club Facebook page. This language will be included in the newly revised SR/Guidelines that will be presented for membership review at the AGM.

New Business:

AMTC Archives – President, Susan Thrasher, noted she received notice of resignation from current Archivist, Ginny Antia. Christina Caridis was nominated by Pres., Susan Thrasher to be the club's archivist. Motion by Ellen Murtagh to approve Christina Caridis as AMTC Archivist. 2nd by Patrick Mackesey. All in favor. Motion carried. The board also agreed that any member requesting information from the archives shall receive copies of requested items as many materials are too fragile to send out.

Christina suggested the club purchase a digital projector for use when presenting Judges' Education, Meet the Breeds, etc. This was tabled until the October meeting.

Electronic Signatures – Christina presented information regarding the use of electronic signatures for utilization by the AMTC. With electronic communication being what it is in this day and age, many corporations, etc. utilize this as a form of legal signature. This would also be a positive addition to processing membership applications. A form will be sent to the membership pertaining to use by the club of members' electronic signatures at a later date.

Bonding of Board Members – it has been suggested that all AMTC Board members be bonded. Dianna will contact our insurance company for information regarding this process.

President's Report – nothing new to report.

Secretary's Report – Kathy Nissen noted she has been organizing and drafting annual reports for presentation at the 2019 AGM. Breed Mentor Provisional Status language was discussed, and a motion made by Dianna Texter, 2nd by Beverly Leidner to approve the provisional status language as presented. All in favor. Motion carried. This will be included in the proposed revisions of the Club's Standing Rules/Guidelines and discussed during presentation of the proposed revisions at the AGM. with this status being retroactive to May 2019.

Purchase of a digital projector tabled until the October 2019 board meeting.

New Business:

1st VP, Christina Caridis presented the names of members, Sabra Weeks and Robin Gates as proposed Governors of Districts 3 and 4 respectively. Due to the recently approved reorganization of districts, four governors chose to step down. Motion to approve appointment of Sabra Weeks and Robin Gates as Dist. Governors for Districts 3 and 4, respectively, made by Dianna Texter. 2nd by Patrick Mackesey. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion to approve utilizing Pay Pal as a means of paying for items purchased at the Annual Awards Banquet and Auction made by Christina Caridis, 2nd by Patrick Mackesey. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the previously proposed utilization of the Electronic Signature Form made by Kathy Nissen, 2nd by Patrick Mackesey. All in favor. Motion carried. This will be included in the proposed revisions of the Club's Standing Rules/Guidelines and discussed during presentation of the proposed revisions at the AGM. If approved at the AGM, this form will be uploaded to the AMTC website.

Due to the possibility of lengthy discussions pertaining to reviewing and hopeful ratification of the proposed Standing Rules/Guidelines revisions, Kathy suggested the board engage a Parliamentarian to conduct the AGM. Character
You have chosen a breed that is wonderful to live with. As a result of their keen intelligence, Manchester Terriers are quick to learn and are capable of excelling in obedience, agility, and coursing events. Since they were bred to hunt vermin and small game, they can do a great job controlling rodents. Although they may be discerning towards strangers, they are fiercely loyal to their master. Once you have experienced living with a Manchester, you will always want at least one in your life.

History
The Manchester Terrier is the oldest of all identifiable Terrier breeds, dating back to the late 1500s. Early references listed him as the Black & Tan Terrier. In the early 1800s, during the time when the sport of Rat Killing was popular, the breed was known for its quick dispensing of rats. In the Manchester District of England, the Black & Tan was crossed with a Whippet to produce a breed that was proficient in both rat killing and rabbit coursing. This successful cross resulted in the development of the Manchester Terrier. Smaller specimens became popular as pets and were selectively bred to be diminutive. They soon bore little resemblance to the larger Manchester Terrier. Eventually two sizes evolved and each became a separate breed in England: the Manchester Terrier and the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan).



Highlights of Breed Standard
The Manchester Terrier is a small, black, short coated dog with rich mahogany markings. He has a taper style tail. The breed has a sleek, sturdy yet elegant look. The long and clean head is wedge shaped, with a keen, bright, alert expression. The smooth, compact, muscular body is built for great power and agility. Except for size and ear options, there is no difference between the Standard and Toy varieties.

Grooming your Manchester
Manchesters are basically "wash & wear dogs." Minimal grooming is required. All that is needed is a brisk brushing with a medium hard brush once a week, trimming and filing of nails once a month, bathing every four to six weeks with a non-detergent shampoo, and brushing or scaling of teeth as needed.

Health Care
To assure that your Manchester remains happy and healthy, be sure to visit your local veterinarian on a regular basis. Annual checkups, routine vaccinations, including rabies shots and tooth care are very important.

Spay/Neuter
This is one of the most important decisions you will make regarding your dog. Neutered dogs typically live longer than those left intact. Males which have been neutered do not have testicular cancer and are at greatly reduced risk of prostate problems, cancerous and otherwise. Dominance and aggression in males is often hormonally linked. Females will not have uterine cancers or uterine infections, which are not uncommon in unspayed females. Mammary tumor incidence is greatly reduced in females spayed before their first season, and a spayed female won't attract neighborhood Romeos. Neutering or spaying

A healthy diet is crucial to your Manchesters well being. Provide a high quality food that helps keep their skin and coat at their best. Your breeder will make recommendations on what foods to use.

will not exclude a dog from many AKC events such as Obedience, Tracking, Earthdog and Agility Trials.

There are many factors to consider before embarking on the commitment that breeding a litter requires. Make sure you spend time educating yourself about the benefits and possible pitfalls of this endeavor. There are workshops and a good deal of reading material that you can utilize—as well as the wealth of knowledge and experience of your new dog's breeder. Attend and participate in conformation dog shows. These shows are for the evaluation of how well dogs match the breed standard. The more you know, the better you will be able to make good, informed decisions about breeding your dog.

Activities
Today, there are many facilities that offer dog training classes from the basic social skills to obedience and agility. Since Manchesters are so very intelligent, you will find they are eager to learn any or all skills presented to them. Basic social training is a must, but, you can have loads of fun training your Manchester for obedience titles. They can also excel in Agility, Earthdog Trials and even in Herding. Manchesters have earned titles in all of the above events.

When Bill RIP died of a massive heart attack, related to diabetes, I was in CT with my parents, visiting. My worst nightmare was unfolding. I called a close friend of ours to check on Bill because I hadn't made contact with him for a week. When he got there it was suspicious, he called the Pasadena police department. I received a call at my parent's home that Bill had died approximately a week prior, his body lay on the dining room floor decomposing. We had nine dogs plus a litter of three puppies; all dogs crated individually, (the sire) Gunner, outside...

I returned home the next day with my brother. My friend Marla Zoz was there before I got in, a 14 drive for her. She never hesitated when she heard my voice and said I'll be there.

Bill was at the Coroners, all dogs our friend brought to his place to sort out. It was terrible...the most gut-wrenching thing I had ever been through. I will spare the details; even today, 20 years later I am still affected deeply by this. If it wasn't for a good friend, I would not have made it through another day.

A miracle, all of our dogs made it without food or water for 7 days. Our then four month old puppies survived! "Gunyon" was one of those puppies. ❤️ In my heart, I truly believe our two holy statues (of many) in home protected the dogs. St. Francis and St. Roch, the patron Saint of dogs.

Whelped in a litter of three, along with two sisters, CH Wilane's Unforgettable, "Cole" and CH Wilane's Ultimate Flyer, MACH3, HOF "Lindy." A very prolific Stud dog, he is known and admired worldwide. Sire to 24 Champions, Obedience, Rally, Flyball and Agility titled; 7 are now inducted into the prestigious Hall of Fame. Proving himself in and out of the ring, leaving his mark with spectacular progeny. Bred only to select bitches producing multi terrier group winning and placing sons and daughters. Grand Champion B, S and G, Best in Specialty winners, AMTC National BOV winner, Westminster KC BOV winners, Montgomery KC BOV and short listed winner with assorted other All Terrier BOV winners and more in performance events.

Consistently throughout the years, this fifth generation, handsome 20.5 # WILANE (AKC registered afix) Stud Dog produced multiple top five-ten Breed and All Breed Manchester Terriers and top honors in the AKC Owner Handler Series.

Our love and my passion for these Black and Tan dogs started in the mid 1980's with our first Manchester. Being involved in the sport of dogs since 1973, we bred our first litter of Doberman's in 1975.

Recognised as AKC Breeder of Merit, Wilane was the first in Manchester Terriers to receive this honor.

We received the Gaines Medal of Good Sportsmanship from the Quinnipiac Doberman Pinscher Club in CT, circa mid '70's and Jo Ann was the first to receive the AKC Good Sportsmanship Medallion offered through the AMTC circa early 2000's.

An extremely proud owner and breeder, member in good standing with the American, British and Canadian Manchester Terrier Clubs. Held the office of President, First Vice President, board position for numerous terms along with District Governorship of the American Manchester Terrier Club.

Today, and throughout many years, Jo Ann has chaired the Judges Education Committee along with the Breed Standard Committee. Her love of the breed shines through.

This wonderful head study of Gunyon was gifted to Jo Ann by Artist, Katie Greer from NOLA. Katie is also a proud owner of a Gunyon son, "Willie" and frequents Bourbon Street and many highlighted happenings in NOLA.

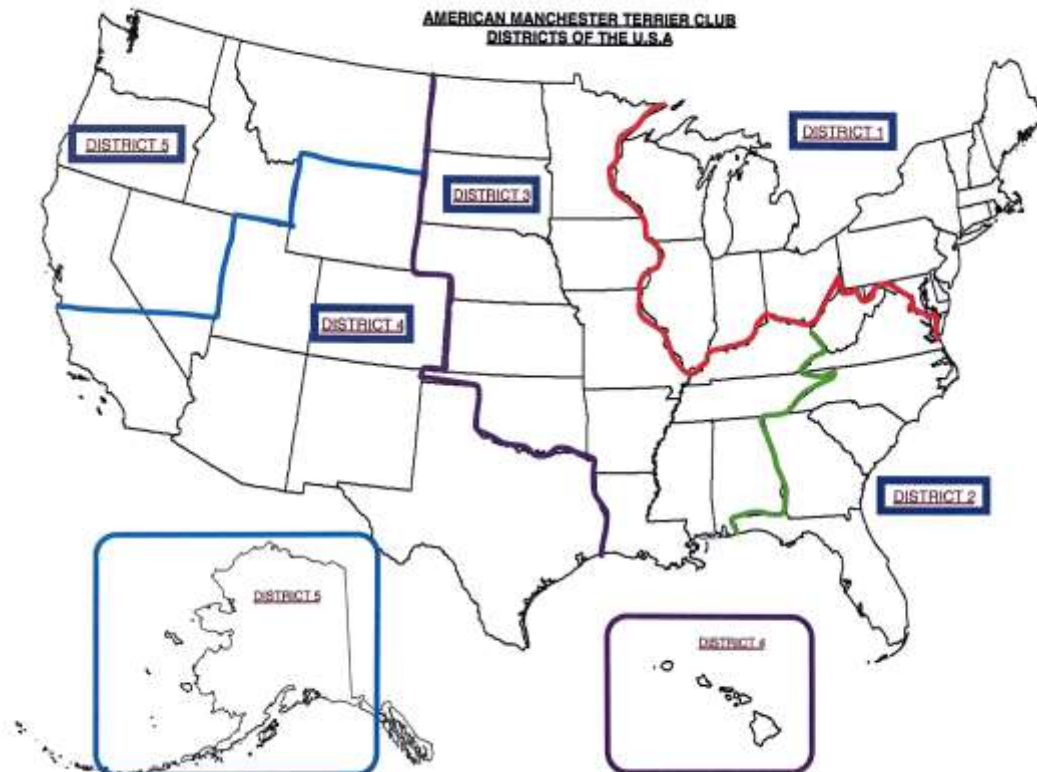

Specs: Sheet size is approximately 20" x 20" with the active design area 13" in diameter. 21" square, 2" deep black gallery

style from with acid-free mat.

Method/Materials: The artwork was hand-drawn digitally using brush-and-India-ink techniques and curving strokes with variation in thickness to create a flowing essence of the three variations of Manchester Terrier, Standard, cropped and button-eared; and Toy varieties. The artwork was individually printed with high-end inkjet technology on a 42" plotter. The 4 color inks produced rich black detail with ink infusing into the firmer of the 60 lb. presentation-grade stock. This is the 1st print.

Commissioned by: Jo Ann Emrick, Texas, USA

I recently retired from day-to-day work in my graphic design and advertising business, so when approach to create a piece of art in support of the American Manchester Terrier Club, I was pleased at the opportunity to once again lend my talents to serve the MT community. The technique to be used was chosen by the client from a users of works I had posted on my Facebook feed. I'd been exploring a relatively new use of recreating paper and media techniques for painting fire art, by transferring those long-held skills to the digital realm.

Initially trained in **watercolour** my work through the years, regardless of medium, has tended to reflect the **free flow** of the medium. Many of my previous works are largely *expressionistic* and generally

colourful. While I admire, and produced, works considered close to *photographic realism*, my preference is to create art that reflects **more than a dogged replication** of the subject but rather to be an artistic *interpretation* of the object being depicted.

I sought to create a piece for this project which would **replicate the liner brush and India ink method** on a **digital** platform. A variable width line is created with a 'real life' sable liner through the tilt of the brush, pressure applied and amount of ink on the brush. Copious experimentation was needed to develop a digital brush that had those same qualities but, through trial and error, an accurate facsimile was created.

This composition, titled **MANCHESTERS THREE: The Essence**, is an example of this line painting technique. The head shapes and feature characteristics were broken down into the **essence** of shape and contrast. The flowing lines create a **contoured representation** of the subjects. Additional elements were added to note the **AMTC 60th** anniversary.

Judge's comments**

What a wonderful honor it was to be invited to judge your 60th Anniversary show. I enjoyed my time with all the exhibitors and breeders during the show and the dinner. You all are to be congratulated for the consistency in your breeding programs - the breed is in good hands. I am overwhelmed with the improvement in the quality of the breed since the first time I judged Manchester's (many years ago).

Special thanks to:

- the exhibitors for their good sportsmanship, and for congratulating the winners.
- the very capable Ring Stewards for keeping things running smoothly. It is a judge's delight to have stewards that know how to help run a smooth and consistent ring.
- hospitality and the Show Chairman - every attention to detail was handled by Christina Caridis and Dianna Texter. Christina is a great lady to have in charge - she went overboard to see that all my questions were handled with grace. Dianna was tops at ring stewarding.
- the five Juniors who showed their dogs with great handling skills. This was one of the most difficult classes I had to evaluate. The competition was very high. Keep up the good work - the dog show community needs you.

When the first class came into the ring I knew that the day was going to be a challenge and lots of fun. Type and soundness were widely evident - with smooth, compact, muscular bodies, proper coat color and markings, wonderful attitudes, the clean heads with alert and bright expressions were the norm for the day, and continued through to the next day. I read a great article that stated - "The dog should be moderate in all aspects. A sound animal that is pleasing to the eye" - and this is the criteria I used in judging.

Super large teeth and generally good bites really impressed me. There were only three or four Manchester's that I felt had either too light of an eye, and/or an eye that was too large and round - most were what your breed standard describes (small, bright and sparkling). Expressions were lovely. Tail sets were generally good - only a couple that were set on too high thus curved over the body too much, which spoils the outline when on the move. Front and rear movement was overall as described in the standard - free and effortless. A few of the Toy variety had a rather high lift in the front legs.

I would like to encourage all of you to PLEASE show your lovely dogs at regular dog show. The judges need to see more of your breed shown to us, to learn just what a wonderful Manchester is supposed to be!!! I have made it a practice to re-read the Standard many times prior to judging any show - but if what we see exhibited does not match what we read about then it becomes difficult to have a proper picture in our minds eye of good "breed type."

My special thanks to all of you for a wonderful two days of having the honor of judging your dogs. Good luck with your 61st show, and may you all have great success with your lovely breed.

Again my sincere thanks to Christina her hard working Club members for everything.

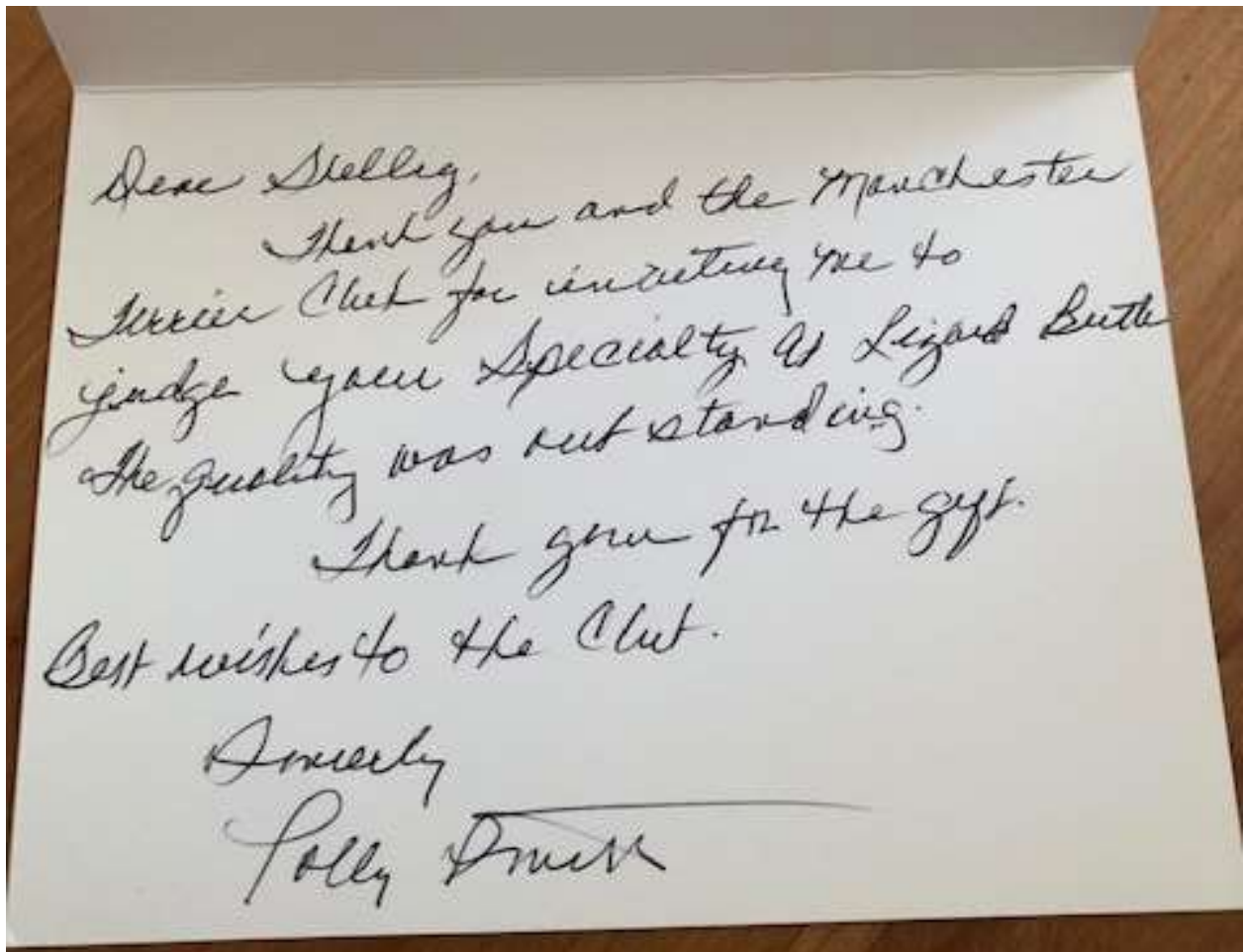

American Manchester Terrier Club Code of Ethics

Membership in the American Manchester Terrier Club (AMTC) is a privilege. In return for acceptance into the AMTC, I promise to abide by the following Code of Ethics and to submit to the enforcement of this Code by the AMTC Board of Directors.

GENERAL

I pledge as an owner of Manchester Terriers to be responsible for the dogs in my care. My responsibilities include providing proper shelter which is clean, dry and warm; appropriate veterinary care and inoculations; emergency veterinary care when needed; quality food and water; adherence to local and state animal control and licensing laws.

BREEDING

I pledge:

1. To accept and uphold the Standard of the Manchester Terrier as developed by the AMTC and approved by the AKC.
2. To breed only physically and mentally sound Manchester Terriers in order to maintain or improve the qualities of the breed as set forth in the Standard. I will not participate in the indiscriminate breeding of studs or bitches with no regard to quality.
3. To screen or obtain proof of screening of breeding stock for communicable diseases, hereditary faults or defects, either active or dormant. Questionable animals will not be used in my breeding program.
4. To forego breeding unless financially capable and willing to responsibly and caringly maintain whelped puppies until placed in their new homes.
5. To maintain complete and accurate breeding records in accordance with AKC regulations.

SELLING

I pledge:

1. To in no way misrepresent any Manchester Terrier for sale.
2. To provide all buyers with:
 - A. AKC individual registration application or certificate properly filled out by seller.
 - B. Minimum three-generation pedigree.
 - C. Record of inoculations, worming, etc.
 - D. Provide instructions for feeding and care.
 - E. Be available for guidance and questions.
3. Not to sell, give, trade, abandon or in any manner transfer litters or individual Manchester Terriers to pet dealers, pet wholesalers, auctions, laboratories, raffles, pet stores, puppy mills, animal shelters, or any source for resale. I will not knowingly transfer ownership or provide stud service to anyone who intends to breed Manchester Terriers for any of the above listed purposes.
4. To take back any Manchester Terrier I bred if the current owner of the dog can no longer keep him or her. I will evaluate the dog as to whether or not s/he is suitable for placing in a new home. In the very unfortunate circumstance that the dog is not suitable, I will either keep the dog myself or provide proper veterinary euthanasia. In the rare event that I cannot take back a dog due to current personal circumstances, I will place the dog in AMTC rescue. I, the breeder, will reimburse any and all reasonable expenses incurred on behalf of a dog in this unusual situation to AMTC rescue.

EXHIBITING

I pledge:

1. To serve as an example of good sportsmanship in any aspect of the sport of dogs, assisting and befriending newcomers to the best of my ability.
2. To show only those Manchester Terriers which deserve to be champions in light of the Standard and which are in proper condition.
3. Not to kennel pack for points in conformation or to engage in any other unfair practices in competition.

PENALTIES

I acknowledge and accept for disciplinary purposes a sliding scale of penalties based upon the seriousness of the deviation from this Code of Ethics. The Board of Directors will apply penalties equally to any and all offenders after a proper review of the evidence. Penalties include but are not limited to: reprimand from the Board; temporary suspension from AMTC membership; permanent suspension from AMTC membership; reporting offenders to the AKC; withholding AMTC awards. I have read and I promise to abide by the above Code of Ethics as set forth by the AMTC.
