
Dear AMTC Board,

To Whom It May Concern:



Manchesters in Agility

GM King with Beth Mathews-Bradshaw and Inez Pennington

Part 1 of 2

Dog agility, or simply agility, is arguably the king of dog sports, in spite of its recent origins. Agility originated in Birmingham, England in the late 1970s as informal entertainment at Crufts. The intent was to entertain exhibitors and audiences by leading a few dogs around a rudimentary course where they showed off what were considered basic, but novel skills: jumping over obstacles, jumping through a tire, etc. This tiny kernel of an idea was an instant hit. It quickly grew from a just a handler or two building their own equipment and creating training plans and foundational rules to a global sport business that can be found virtually everywhere people love dogs.

Agility is now a formal sport with numerous sponsors, including the AKC, the US Dog Agility Association (USDAA), the United Kingdom International (UKI), the North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC), and the Fédération Cyanologique Internationale (FCI), among others. Competition is typically open to all dogs, mixed and purebred, of all sizes. Competitions, or trials, can be found throughout the US and abroad, with some venues hosting trials on a weekly basis year-round. Training and support can also be found through widely available in-person classes, online instruction (usually paid), and a variety of books. Numerous Facebook groups also offer supportive communities.

In the US, national level competitions are sponsored by the AKC (the National Agility Championship and the Agility Invitational), USDAA, UKI, and others. In addition to stand alone trials at local levels, agility competitions are often held in conjunction with major conformation shows, including Westminster and Crufts. Several international competitions sponsored by the UKI, FCI, and others bring together teams from around the world annually.

Agility is open to competitors of all ages and abilities. As is often the case with other sports, juniors are especially welcomed and encouraged. Handlers with disabilities can and do compete. Watching someone in a wheelchair guide their partner around a course always leaves this handler in awe, just as it's awesome to watch a 96-yr old complete a course and earn a Q!

A consistent theme that unites agility at all levels and across all handlers is the affection shared between dogs and handlers and the joy that both experience doing their jobs. It's the interaction with companions, the adrenaline and endorphin rushes during and after competition, and the camaraderie among handlers that results in what many people refer to as their agility addiction and to label themselves as agility junkies. This is an addiction we can we all need to see grow!

A detailed description of agility is beyond the scope of this article but general informative resources follow. The interviews (lightly edited) offer personal insights from two of the top Manchester Terrier agility handlers, Beth Mathews-Bradshaw and Inez Pennington. Since it's not possible to interview all of the top handlers, a special shout out is offered to here to just a few of many: Marit Alsager, Kathy Baer, Linda Hurley, Jerri Gillean, Yoko Katz, Diane Krumme, Susan Ramsbottom, Tonya Sims, Elaine Sperry, and Linda Zaeske (not an exclusive list!).
Agility is king, long live agility!

Beth Mathews-Bradshaw

GMK: As a National Agility Championship winner in the 12" class, you've obviously achieved great success in agility. How long did it take you to get there and can you describe the path(s) you've taken?

BMB: I've been doing agility since I stopped showing horses in 1999. I started with dobs and have had border collies and Manchesters since then. I don't know as I've had a specific path, I started taking lessons in Ohio where I lived, and then moved to Virginia in 2001 and started taking lessons
GMK: Your Manchesters excel in agility. Do you and your dogs have time for anything else? When you're not doing agility, what do you do for additional fun? What do your Manchesters like to do?

BMB: We hike/walk a good bit. You have to for their fitness as well as their mental health. Some of my retired dogs have done rally so they have their time with me and still get to work. They like to play Frisbee but I don't do too much of that as I prefer their non-working days to be less intensive like hiking to give their bodies a rest. I also ride and occasionally show my horses although I'm not as serious about that as I am the agility.

GMK: Do you have a favorite story about your most fun agility experience? Has there been a worst story you can tell? If your Manchesters could tell us a story about you or themselves, what do you think they'd say?

BMB: I don't think I have a most fun experience, but I do really enjoy big events where people want to see the dogs, like Westminster and the Invitational. I think it's good for dogs in general and certainly for dog sports. My worst memory is my dog having a bad fall off the dogwalk in California at one of the first Invitationals. My most bittersweet one was of sitting outside the ring after running Pixel, who was 10 at the time, feeding her cookies and just watching all the other runs afterwards, just spending time with her by the ring. As it turns out she had cancer and it was the last show we would do. As to what they would say – it depends on the day! I fell down once in a run sending to a tunnel because my shoes were wet, Pixel came out of the tunnel, never even looked my way as she headed straight for the weaves which were the next obstacle, and I swear she said you'd better be on your feet and at the end of these weaves when I get there because you are embarrassing me!

GMK: You've reached the pinnacle for AKC agility. What's next for you? What motivates you to keep pushing yourself and your companions?

BMB: Well, I don't think of agility being so linear. I think it's a journey you take with each dog and each dog is different so each journey is different. I've debated trying out for teams. I'm not sure I'm quite that consistently good, and you have to be lucky enough to have a competitive dog that is the right height and travels well for that. I like to aim for nationals, Invitationals, Westminster. I don't care much about titles. Half the time I don't know if mine get a MACH after their first one as I'm notoriously terrible at tracking Qs and scores. Don't get me wrong, I like to do well just as much as the next competitive person, but I'm more about figuring out how I can be the best dog/handler team we can be on any particular course on any particular day. What I love about agility is being in the moment – where all you are thinking about is that run, handling that dog, and everything else goes away. That's why I do agility.

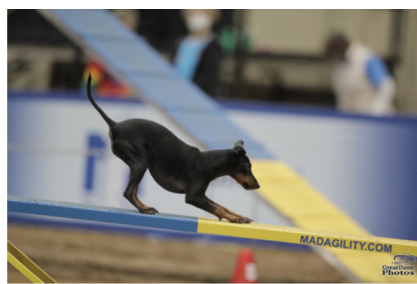
About Beth Mathews-Bradshaw:

Beth has been training and showing in agility for over 20 years. She has handled dogs of all sizes and breeds from Dobermans and Border Collies to 6-pound toy Manchesters. She currently lives in Haymarket, Virginia with her husband, 4 dogs, 2 horses and 2 cats. She has some of the top Manchester terriers in the U.S., with many consistently making the top 5 each year to attend the AKC Agility Invitational.

Beth shows in AKC and UKI, has made the podium in both venues with multiple dogs (Pixel, Prix, Bounce and Diesel) at events such as the US Open, Westminster, the AKC Agility Invitational and AKC Nationals, including winning the 2021 12" AKC Nationals with Prix. Beth enjoys teaching and helping people with their dogs, and in her spare time hikes with her dogs and competes with her horses at Hunter/Jumper shows.

American Manchester Terrier Club Code of Ethics

Membership in the American Manchester Terrier Club (AMTC) is a privilege. In return for acceptance into the AMTC, I promise to abide by the following Code of Ethics and to submit to the enforcement of this Code by the AMTC Board of Directors.

GENERAL

I pledge as an owner of Manchester Terriers to be responsible for the dogs in my care. My responsibilities include providing proper shelter which is clean, dry and warm; appropriate veterinary care and inoculations; emergency veterinary care when needed; quality food and water; adherence to local and state animal control and licensing laws.

BREEDING

I pledge:

1. To accept and uphold the Standard of the Manchester Terrier as developed by the AMTC and approved by the AKC.
2. To breed only physically and mentally sound Manchester Terriers in order to maintain or improve the qualities of the breed as set forth in the Standard. I will not participate in the indiscriminate breeding of studs or bitches with no regard to quality.
3. To screen or obtain proof of screening of breeding stock for communicable diseases, hereditary faults or defects, either active or dormant. Questionable animals will not be used in my breeding program.
4. To forego breeding unless financially capable and willing to responsibly and caringly maintain whelped puppies until placed in their new homes.
5. To maintain complete and accurate breeding records in accordance with AKC regulations.

SELLING

I pledge:

1. To in no way misrepresent any Manchester Terrier for sale.
2. To provide all buyers with:
 - A. AKC individual registration application or certificate properly filled out by seller.
 - B. Minimum three-generation pedigree.
 - C. Record of inoculations, worming, etc.
 - D. Provide instructions for feeding and care.
 - E. Be available for guidance and questions.
3. Not to sell, give, trade, abandon or in any manner transfer litters or individual Manchester Terriers to pet dealers, pet wholesalers, auctions, laboratories, raffles, pet stores, puppy mills, animal shelters, or any source for resale. I will not knowingly transfer ownership or provide stud service to anyone who intends to breed Manchester Terriers for any of the above listed purposes.
4. To take back any Manchester Terrier I bred if the current owner of the dog can no longer keep him or her. I will evaluate the dog as to whether or not s/he is suitable for placing in a new home. In the very unfortunate circumstance that the dog is not suitable, I will either keep the dog myself or provide proper veterinary euthanasia. In the rare event that I cannot take back a dog due to current personal circumstances, I will place the dog in AMTC rescue. I, the breeder, will reimburse any and all reasonable expenses incurred on behalf of a dog in this unusual situation to AMTC rescue.

EXHIBITING

I pledge:

1. To serve as an example of good sportsmanship in any aspect of the sport of dogs, assisting and befriending newcomers to the best of my ability.
2. To show only those Manchester Terriers which deserve to be champions in light of the Standard and which are in proper condition.
3. Not to kennel pack for points in conformation or to engage in any other unfair practices in competition.

PENALTIES

I acknowledge and accept for disciplinary purposes a sliding scale of penalties based upon the seriousness of the deviation from this Code of Ethics. The Board of Directors will apply penalties equally to any and all offenders after a proper review of the evidence. Penalties include but are not limited to: reprimand from the Board; temporary suspension from AMTC membership; permanent suspension from AMTC membership; reporting offenders to the AKC; withholding AMTC awards. I have read and I promise to abide by the above Code of Ethics as set forth by the AMTC.
